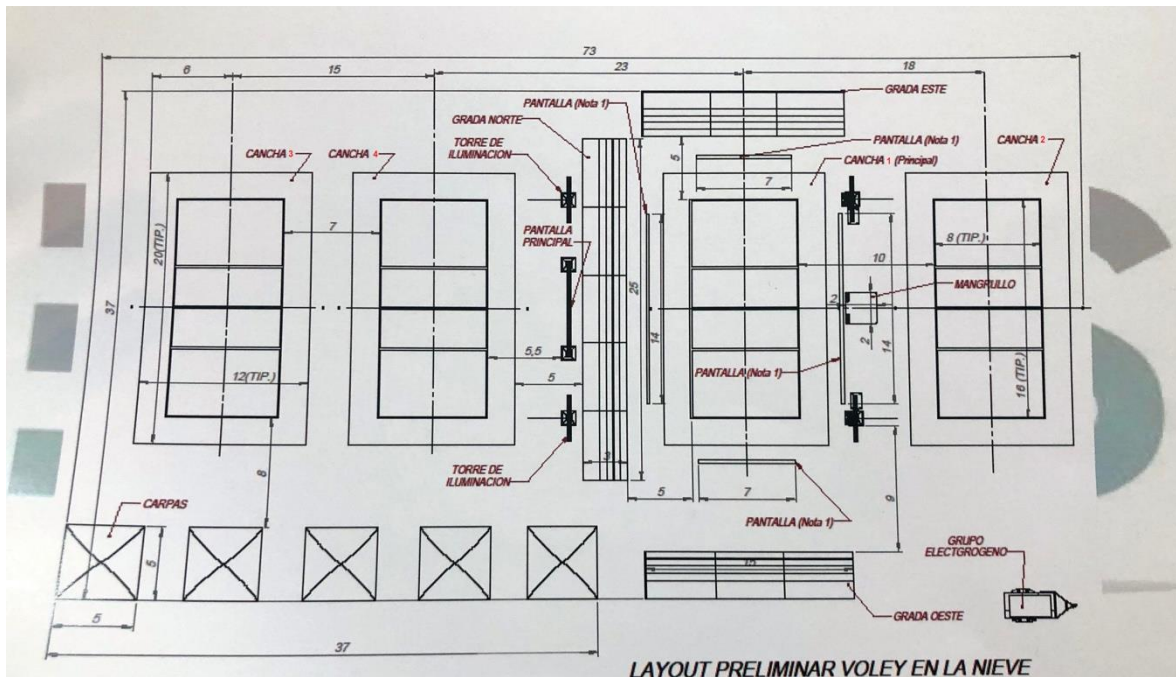

COUNTRY QUOTA

Main Draw: max. 1 team per country directly in the Main Draw plus any eventual the exception of wild card

Qualification: max. 1 team for the host country plus any eventual wild card wild cards.
After the registration deadline and in case the Qualification roster is not complete the country quota is released aiming to reach a maximum number of teams in the Qualification tournament. Late entries will be possible on the basis of who will enter teams first will first have the right to compete in the Qualification tournament until the 16 teams roster per gender is full. Any eventual 2nd teams which will be allowed to fill the roster will have priority in accordance with their earliest entry date.

TEAMS ENTRY PROCEDURE

Tentative Entry List

Any eligible athletes/teams can be entered in the Tentative Entry List through the VIS until **-30 days** (1st of July 2019 – 12am Swiss time) before the start of the event. Invited Continental quota teams need to confirm their participation through the participation confirmation form also by the **1st of July**.

Confirmed Entry List

Athlete Entry Points are used to determine which teams have earned berth(s) into the Qualification and into the Reserve Team List (Main Draw composition see above).

The Confirmed Entry List will be issued between **-29 days and -21 days** before the start of the event (latest on the 11th of July 2019).

Late Entries

The enrolment shall be requested by email to vis@fivb.org by the **1th of July 2019** - 12 am Swiss time latest. Late entries will be possible on the basis of who will enter teams first will first have the right to compete in the Qualification tournament until the 16 teams roster per gender is full. However, late entries after the 1st of July deadline will be not accepted in the main draw if the MD roster will be completed. This irrespective of the points of the late entry teams.

Wild card requests can be submitted to the FIVB through the NFs **-30 days** (1 July 2019) prior to the start of the event through [the form](#).

During the tournament local transportation will be granted by the organizers as follows:

31 July — For the preliminary inquiry the shuttle will departure from the Hotel Panamericano to the Villa Huinid at 17:30. While the captains will remain until the end of the technical meeting the remaining players can return to their hotel at 19:30.

1 August - Departure from the respective hotels will be at 8:15 for all officials and staff and 8:30 for all players taking part in the qualification tournament from the meeting point of the Hotel NH Edelweiss.

From 2-4 August - Departure from the respective hotels will be at 8:15 for all officials and staff and 8:30 for all players.

Return shuttle to the hotels for the players will be scheduled 15 minutes after the last match of the day. The departure time of a shuttle from the hotel to Bariloche airport will be communicated to the players during the event.

VISA

Athletes (or their National Federations) are encouraged to apply early enough for the entry visas (if required). All visa expenses have to be borne by the applicants themselves. For any enquiry regarding your visa application and invitation letter, please contact: **Sabrina Kock** sabrinadeportesrn@gmail.com

WITHDRAWAL

The procedure of withdrawal will be as follows:

- a. Before the Confirmed List, the National Federation shall withdraw the team directly in the VIS,
- b. Between the Confirmed List and the last Monday (17:00 CET) before the event, the National Federation shall send the [SV-03](#) form with a medical certificate or letter specifying a Force Majeure,
- c. Between the last Monday (17:00 CET) and the relevant Preliminary Inquiry, the National Federation shall send the [SV-03](#) form or letter specifying a Force Majeure and inform the

- assigned Technical Delegate. In addition, a monetary sanction of 300 USD is applied for a withdrawal in the main draw and USD 100 for a withdrawals in the qualification tournament,
- d. After the relevant Preliminary Inquiry and if due to an injury, the Team captain shall sign the score sheet at the time and place where such match was originally scheduled even if this match will not be played.

The FIVB reserves a right to place a main draw team in the qualification due to a change of players which may affect significantly the entry points of a team. Should the team requesting the change of player(s) have not enough entry points to stay in the main draw, it will be replaced automatically by the highest team enrolled in the qualification in accordance with the entry points as per — 21 days prior to the start of the event.

When a medical reason or a Force majeure is to be evidenced, all proofs are submitted in English or with an English translation before the relevant Preliminary Inquiry. The medical reason is evidenced only by a medical certificate. The Force majeure by any reasonable means.

When the player is in the Reserve list, the obligation to evidence the medical reason is not needed.

In case of the withdrawal(s) of team(s) in the Main Draw tournament prior to the start of the completion of the Preliminary Inquiry of the Qualification Tournament, the next eligible team(s) with the highest FIVB Entry Points in the Qualification Tournament shall be picked up to advance to the Main Draw, respecting the regulations of the country quota.

In case of the withdrawal(s) of team(s) in the Main Draw tournament after the completion of Preliminary Inquiry of the Qualification Tournament when the Qualification seeding list and match schedule have been developed, the regulations of the lucky loser draw shall be implemented to determine the extra team(s) qualify to the Main Draw.

The Lucky loser draw regulation is as follows:

- The lucky loser draw is conducted by the assigned FIVB Technical Delegate after the completion of the Preliminary Inquiry of Main Draw;
- The lucky loser draw is implemented among the teams losing the last round of the Qualification Tournament, provided they attend and sign in at the Preliminary Inquiry of Main Draw tournament as eligible 'lucky losers';
- The first draw is between the two highest seeded teams among the eligible 'lucky loser';
- For each additional available spot in the Main Draw, the next highest seeded team must be drawn against the loser of the previous draw;
- This procedure continues until all additional open spots of the Main Draw are filled.

SEEDING

Once all the participating teams are known and have confirmed their presence during the Preliminary Inquiry, the teams will be seeded in the competition bracket. The seeding will be determined by the FIVB Snow Volleyball Ranking points for all involved teams during the Technical Meeting. A draw can be carried out only for teams with the same amount of points even if they

have 0 points.

The Host Country teams must never be placed in the same pool. These team(s) will have their seed increased (i.e. from Seed #8 to Seed #9) until they are in a different pool than already seeded Host Country teams. Should increasing the seed not work (or not be possible), then the seed will be reduced (i.e. from Seed #12 to Seed #11) until the team(s) is placed in a different pool.

Finalized seeding list and the match up & additional detailed information regarding the competition will be published on the FIVB website immediately once the seeding list is established.

PLAYERS' ELIGIBILITY

All athletes participating in the FIVB snow volleyball sanctioned event must:

- Hold the citizenship of the country they represent;
- Register with their respective NF;
- Register with the FIVB through their respective NF;
- Present the 2019 Snow Volleyball NF-Athlete's Commitment signed by the NF and the athlete during the Preliminary Inquiry;
- Present an annual health certificate (SV-10) during the Preliminary Inquiry;
- Undertake the FIVB Anti-Doping education program "Play clean!". For further information please access FIVB online Anti-Doping education program here: <http://playclean.fivb.com>
- Complete the FIVB Manipulation Course: <https://www.fivb.com/development/manipulationcourse>
- Complete and modify his/her personal data (such as his/her exact coordinates, bank account information, etc.) through the FIVB beach volleyball Web based application system (<http://www.fivb.org/visasp>)

UNIFORM AND ACCESSORIES

Uniforms and accessories will be checked during the Preliminary Inquiry by the FIVB Technical Delegate. All athletes will be required to have the necessary clothes and accessories to compete on the snow with low temperature which may be -10C degrees and above. Football boots with a strong grip on the snow will be also required to play snow volleyball. The shoes, gloves and other accessories should be made from the materials, which do not produce any danger to the players, teammates or opponents.

While athlete's tops will be provided by the Organizers, shorts/leggings and accessories have to be purchased by the athletes and/or provided by their sponsors. Players are permitted to wear equipment composed of a close-fitting t-shirt with long or short sleeves and long tight pants. The FIVB encourages to wear thermal clothes and accessories which can reflect the color(s) of the participating countries. This is to create a country vs country image during the official matches.

Men's athletes may wear shorts over the long tight pants. The uniforms have to be consistent in style, length and color for all players in the team.

Athletes are authorized to use the following accessories:

- a. Visor/cap/hat/headband
- b. Knee and/or elbow pads
- c. Sunglasses
- d. One watch
- e. Gloves
- f. Two Armbands

Sponsor/Manufacturer

No sponsor logos are permitted on close-fitting t-shirts and thermal wear pants except the manufacturer logo that cannot exceed 20cm². Sponsors logos are allowed on men's shorts and women's leggings (or shorts). There are no limitations concerning the position and size of sponsors logos On the accessories, the athletes are allowed to display a maximum of 2 sponsors (72cm² each) plus the manufacturer's logo.



4) Double-click on the registered team. Click on „Add player(s)“ and select the players to be added.

ACCREDITATION

Organizers will provide all Organizing Committee members, Officials, referees, athletes, VIPs, journalists, technical staff, court personnel, volunteers, etc. with an official accreditation card and will ensure that only people with appropriate accreditation will access the designated venue areas.

INSURANCE

Athletes need to have their own liability and medical insurance.

MEDICAL-DOPING CONTROLS

The FIVB reserves the right to perform random medical-doping controls of the participating athletes and alcohol tests of the officials, as per FIVB rules and regulations.

I. Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE):

If a player has taken any prohibited substances, he must have a valid Therapeutic Use Exemption Approval (M-8 form) delivered by the FIVB prior to the event, except in case of emergency.

II. First aid and medical treatment will be provided by the Organizer under the control of the FIVB Technical Delegate.

- First aid facilities, medical doctor and nurse in each competition for the players and spectators.
- First aid at the venue (nurse, medical supplies).
- First aid for players in the hotel or doctors on call.

III. Ambulance is highly recommended in front of the competition hall, in any case, the time to get an ambulance should be less than 10 minutes.

IV. Determination of hospital for possible hospitalization is mandatory.

VI. Before each match the team manager must proceed to the Scorer's table with, the identification of the players (accreditations, ID Cards or passports)

VII. All team delegations are recommended to take out their own third-party liability and medical insurance. All teams waive any claims on local Organizers and the FIVB for injuries sustained during the event.

IX. Doping controls may be conducted under the supervision of the FIVB Technical Delegate with the cooperation of the Medical Delegates (if any), in accordance with the FIVB Medical & Anti-Doping Regulations. Doping controls may be conducted at any time by WADA (World Anti-Doping Agency or any other authorized sample collection providers in accordance with FIVB agreements).
