



AVC Qualification System To the 2023 FIVB Beach Volleyball World Championships

1. Max Total Quota from AVC Qualification Pathway

- Men: 4 teams (8 athletes)
- Women: 4 teams (8 athletes)

2. Type of allocation of Quota places

The quota place is allocated to the National Federation (NF).

3. Athlete Eligibility

Each participating athlete must comply with the criteria set forth in 3. Athletes Eligibility of circulated Qualification System document ([link](#)).

There are no additional AVC eligibility criteria.

4. Qualification Pathway

4.1 AVC Qualification period will be based on AVC Beach Volleyball NF Ranking calculated from 22nd August 2022 to 21st August 2023.

All Beach Pro Tour tournaments within the above-mentioned period, plus all below AVC homologated tournaments will be included in the AVC Qualification process:

- 2022 AVC Beach Tour Roi-et Open (Women) on 10 to 12 Sept 2022
- 2022 Asian Beach Volleyball Championships (Women) on 14 to 17 Sept 2022
- 2022 AVC Beach Tour Samila Open (Men and Women) on 21 to 25 Sept 2022
- 2022 AVC Beach Tour Bandar Abbas Open (Men) on 7 to 11 Nov 2022
- 2022 Asian Beach Volleyball Championships (Men) on 14 to 18 Nov 2022
- 2023 AVC Beach Tour Samila Open (Men and Women) on 14 to 17 April 2023
- 2023 Asian Beach Volleyball Championships (Men and Women) on 22 to 25 June 2023
- 2023 AVC Beach Tour Penghu Open (Men and Women) on 17 to 20 Aug 2023

4.2 The four (4) highest ranks per gender as per the above-mentioned AVC Beach Volleyball NF Ranking will qualify to the 2023 FIVB Beach Volleyball World Championships, respecting the maximum number of quota places per NF per gender and the provisions established in the 2023 FIVB Beach Volleyball World Championships Qualification System document ([link](#)).

4.3 The calculation of AVC Beach Volleyball National Federation Ranking are as follows:

- The top four (4) ranking points results from the AVC tournaments above-mentioned in 4.1, will be counted towards the calculation of the AVC Beach

Volleyball NF Ranking. Only the best result of AVC Beach Volleyball Championships finishes will be calculated to be included in the total.

Then the top four (4) ranking points results at Beach Pro Tour tournaments above-mentioned in 4.1, will be added to the total to be calculated to establish the eventual AVC Beach Volleyball NF Ranking.

- The ranking points of the best two (2) teams from each NF per gender from each of tournaments above-mentioned in 4.1, will be counted towards the calculation of the AVC Beach Volleyball NF Ranking.
- The ranking points earned with the best result will be labelled as NF 1 finish and second-best result will be labelled as NF 2 finish.
- The sum of all NF 1 ranking points obtained in the top four (4) finishes at AVC tournaments plus the top four (4) finishes at the Beach Pro Tour tournaments within the above-mentioned period in 4.1, that the NF concerned participated will be the final ranking points of NF 1, regardless of the different players' composition of the team in each tournament, but not including result obtained by an athlete that has qualified to the 2023 FIVB Beach Volleyball World Championships through FIVB Entry Ranking of 21st August 2023.
- The sum of all NF 2 ranking points obtained in the top four (4) finishes at AVC tournaments plus the top four (4) finishes at the Beach Pro Tour tournaments within the above-mentioned period in 4.1, that the NF concerned participated will be the final ranking points of NF 2, regardless of the different players' composition of the team in each tournament, but not including result obtained by an athlete that has qualified to the 2023 FIVB Beach Volleyball World Championships through FIVB Entry Ranking of 21st August 2023.
- There will be maximum 2 ranks from the same NF per gender in the AVC Volleyball NF Ranking. Accordingly, it is possible to have 2 ranks from the same NF per gender among the four (4) highest ranks in the AVC Qualification pathway. However, if an NF qualifies a team through the FIVB Entry Ranking of 21st August 2023, any results of both athletes of such team will not be used for calculation of AVC Beach Volleyball NF Ranking, and the next highest result of the team from the concerned NF will be picked up for the calculation accordingly.
- In the case there is a tie in the AVC Beach Volleyball NF Ranking, the tie will be broken firstly by the best result obtained by the NF in 2023 Asian Beach Volleyball Championships; and there is still a tie, then the NF with best result obtained in 2022 Asian Beach Volleyball Championships ranks higher; and if there is still a tie, then the NF with highest points obtained from all tournaments above-mentioned in 4.1 will rank higher; and if there is still a tie, a drawing of lots will be conducted by the AVC to break the tie as the last resort.

CAVB Qualification System To the 2023 FIVB Beach Volleyball World Championships

1. Max Total Quota from CAVB Qualification Pathway

- Men: 4 teams (8 athletes)
- Women: 4 teams (8 athletes)

2. Type of allocation of Quota places

The quota place is allocated to the National Federation (NF).
Only one team per gender per NF will qualify.

3. Athlete Eligibility

Each participating athlete must comply with the criteria set forth in 3. Athletes Eligibility of circulated Qualification System document ([link](#)).

There are no additional CAVB eligibility criteria.

4. Qualification Pathway

4.1 Four (4) top ranked teams at CAVB Beach Volleyball African Championships held in the Agadir, Morocco on 27th July to 1st August 2022 will qualify to the 2023 FIVB Beach Volleyball World Championships, respecting maximum one team per gender per NF will qualify.

4.2 Should there be more than two (2) teams from the same NF amongst the four (4) top ranked team at above-mentioned tournament, the next best ranked team, not yet qualified to the 2023 FIVB Beach Volleyball World Championships, will obtain the quota place for their NF.

CEV Qualification System To the 2023 FIVB Beach Volleyball World Championships

1. Max Total Quota from CEV Qualification Pathway

- Men: 4 teams (8 athletes)
- Women: 4 teams (8 athletes)

2. Type of allocation of Quota places

The quota place is allocated to the team.

3. Athlete Eligibility

Each participating athlete must comply with the criteria set forth in 3. Athletes Eligibility of circulated Qualification System document ([link](#)).

There are no additional CEV eligibility criteria.

4. Qualification Pathway

4.1 One (1) quota place per gender will be allocated to the winning team of Eurobeachvolley 2023 held in Vienna, Austria the period 2 to 6 of August 2023.

Should one or both of the above team(s) already have sufficient 2023 Beach Volleyball World Championships (WCHs) FIVB Ranking points to be placed among the top twenty-five (25) teams per gender of 21st of August 2023, the quota place(s) concerned will be reallocated to the next highest ranked eligible European team(s) of the same gender (maximum quota conditions considered), not yet qualified as per the WCHs FIVB Ranking points of the 21st of August 2023.

4.2 Three (3) quota places per gender will be allocated to the next three (3) highest ranked eligible European teams not yet qualified through FIVB Ranking Points to the 2023 FIVB Beach Volleyball World Championships, as of 21st of August 2023, whose NF has not yet obtained the maximum quota places (i.e. four (4) for foreign participating NF).

4.3 Before the Drawing of lots for the Pool phase, in case there is change of player request for an athlete qualified from CEV qualification pathway, the new team shall have enough entry points as of 21st of August 2023 to maintain its position. Otherwise, the quota place will be re-allocated to the next highest ranked eligible team from CEV not yet qualified, as per FIVB Entry Ranking of 21st of August 2023, provided that their NF has not yet obtained the maximum quota places (i.e. four (4) for foreign NF).

4.4 Before the Drawing of lots for the Pool phase, in case there is withdrawal request of a team qualified from CEV qualification pathway, the team shall be replaced by the next highest ranked eligible European team, not yet qualified, as per FIVB Entry Ranking of 21st of August 2023, provided that their NF has not yet obtained the maximum quota places (i.e. four (4) for foreign NF).

CSV Qualification System To the 2023 FIVB Beach Volleyball World Championships

1. Max Total Quota from CSV Qualification Pathway

- Men: 4 teams (8 athletes)
- Women: 4 teams (8 athletes)

2. Type of allocation of Quota places

The quota place is allocated to the National Federation (NF).

Only one team per gender per NF will qualify as per the CSV ranking.

3. Athlete Eligibility

Each participating athlete must comply with the criteria set forth in 3. Athletes Eligibility of circulated Qualification System document ([link](#)).

There are no additional CSV eligibility criteria.

4. Qualification Pathway

4.1 CSV Qualification period will be the 2022/2023 season until the CSV Continental Tour Finals (i.e. CSV Beach Volleyball Championships, scheduled in May 2023).

4.2 The four (4) highest ranked National Federations per gender, based on the sum of all 2022/2023 season CSV events, with the lowest ranking points during the season being discarded, will qualify to the 2023 FIVB Beach Volleyball World Championships, respecting the maximum number of quota places per NF per gender (i.e. four (4) for foreign participating NF).

4.3 The CSV NF Rankings are based on the cumulative total of the CSV NF points earned at CSV Continental Tour events in above-mentioned period in 4.1. CSV NF points are awarded to the highest finishing NF team at each CSV Beach Tour event.

4.4 Athletes who qualify through FIVB Entry Ranking of 21st August 2023 will not be included for the calculation of CSV ranking for their NF. Consequently, their points will be switched to points earned by another NF team or dropped if no other team from their NF participated in the same tournament.

NORCECA Qualification System To the 2023 FIVB Beach Volleyball World Championships

1. Max Total Quota from NORCECA

- Men: 4 teams (8 athletes)
- Women: 4 teams (8 athletes)

2. Type of allocation of Quota places

The quota place is allocated to the National Federation (NF).

3. Athlete Eligibility

Each participating athlete must comply with the criteria set forth in 3. Athletes Eligibility of circulated Qualification System document ([link](#)).

There are no additional NORCECA eligibility criteria.

4. Qualification Pathway

- 4.1 The NORCECA Beach Volleyball Qualification Tournament to the 2023 FIVB Beach Volleyball World Championships, scheduled on 29 May – 1 June 2023 in Punta Cana, Dominican Republic, will decide the four (4) quota places per gender from NORCECA qualification pathway. Such Qualification tournament will be divided into two (2) pools of six (6) teams per gender and the top two (2) winners of each pool will be awarded the quota place for the 2023 FIVB Beach Volleyball World Championships, provided that their NF has not yet obtained the maximum quota places (i.e. four (4) for foreign NF and six (6) for host NF Mexico).
- 4.2 Each National Federation is allowed to register one (1) team per gender to the above-mentioned Qualification Tournament, and the registration is open to top twelve (12) National Federation as of NORCECA Beach Volleyball NF Ranking. (Details refer to **Appendix 1**)
- 4.3 In the case that any National Federation declines its participation, the next eligible National Federation as per NORCECA Beach Volleyball NF Ranking (appendix 1) will be picked up.
- 4.4 Should the NF from the top two (2) of any pool of the Qualification Tournament obtain the full quota place (i.e. (4) for foreign NF and six (6) for host NF Mexico) through the FIVB Entry Ranking of 21st August 2023, such quota place from NORCECA Qualification Tournament will be reallocated to the next best ranked National Federation of the above-mentioned qualification tournament.
- 4.5 Should one or more of the above qualified National Federations decide not to use the quota place obtained from the NORCECA qualification pathway to the 2023 FIVB Beach Volleyball World Championships, the quota place(s) will be then reallocated to the next best ranked eligible team/NF (i.e. 5th, 6th 7th and 8th, etc. as per the final ranking of the above-mentioned tournament. After all above efforts are explored, upon consideration of

NORCECA and upon approval of the FIVB, the other National Federation qualified through NORCECA qualification pathway can use the quota place(s) until fulfilling the maximum quota place (i.e. four (4) per National Federation) if needed. In any case, NORCECA will use the entire quota place of 4 vacancies per gender.

- 4.6 An athlete can obtain a maximum of one (1) quota place for his/her NF to the 2023 FIVB Beach Volleyball World Championships. Should an athlete qualifies through both the FIVB Entry Ranking and the NORCECA Continental Qualification pathway, its quota place will be confirmed through FIVB Entry Ranking qualification pathway, while the quota place(s) will be then reallocated to the next best ranked eligible team/NF as per the final ranking of the above-mentioned tournament, provided that their NF has not yet obtained the maximum quota places (i.e. four (4) for foreign NF and six (6) for host NF Mexico).
